EVOLUTION, SCIENCE, AND THE BIBLE

The debate between Evolutionists and Creationists has heated up greatly over the past two years. On the one hand, science teachers at both the college and high school levels, who discuss 'Intelligent Design' in the classroom, are being denied tenure, made to teach courses other than science, or are outright fired. THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

A STUDY OF LUTHER'S COMMENTARY ON SCRIPTURE USED IN HANDEL'S MESSIAH

Our class will listen to selected portions of Handel's Messiah while reading Martin Luther's commentaries on the verses used by Handel. We will start with Part 3 which deals with the Resurrection of the Dead (Luther has 17 sermons on 1 Corinthians 15 to choose from) and work backward to Part 2 which deals with Christ's Passion (Luther has Holy Week Sermons available from 1529 and 1532).
