

Intentional or "oops" ?

A Biblical Mandate

The concept behind Family Nights is rooted in a Biblical mandate summarized in Deuteronomy 6:5-9

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children."

How?

"Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates."

Why?

Family 1st Sunday is designed to provide a Faith and Fellowship event specifically geared towards families with children. The Youth Worship Band will lead us in contemporary worship followed by Bible activities, Biblical skits, and hands on learning opportunities.

Family 1st Sunday provides a way for families to prioritize and take time once a month to build relationships with one another and with our Savior, Jesus Christ. When parents make it a priority to devise a meaningful, simple plan to touch base with the entire family unit via a "family night together," God honors that commitment by transfiguring it into a 'tie that binds' you together in unity in the faith, and in your commitment to one another. Our hope is that Family 1st Sunday will involve families and individuals in learning activities at church that can be extended into their homes.
